

Student Attendance

It is expected that all students and their families attend Mass as well as religious education class each week.

Children are expected to participate in each class session. **All absences are to be phoned in, or e-mailed to, the RE office prior to the start of class.** If there is a family emergency and your child cannot attend class, please call the Religious Education Office to find out how your child can make up a missed session.

You will be contacted if your child misses two classes in a row

If your child misses three total classes, the DRE will contact you and request a conference. All absences in excess of 3 must be made up by attending the other class time slot.

Student Attendance for children in 2nd Grade: Church Law requires that children be properly prepared before celebrating First Reconciliation and First Holy Communion. It is essential that children who are preparing for these Sacraments are present at **all** class sessions and activities. If your child misses two classes, the DRE will contact you and request a conference.

Student Attendance for teens in 9th Grade: Church Law requires that children be properly prepared before celebrating Confirmation. It is essential that teens who are preparing for Confirmation are present at **all** class sessions and ministerial activities. If your teen misses two classes, the Confirmation Coordinator will contact you and request a conference.
