TECHNOLOGY

We offer a state of the art computer lab featuring computers with up-to-date integrated technology. Students are immersed in a multi-faceted curriculum taught by our technology specialist multiple times per week.

SPORTS

As part of a well-rounded education, the school offers Boys and Girls Basketball, Cross Country, and Volleyball in a competitive conference beginning in Grade 4 or 5. Running Club is an additional extra curricular beginning in Grade 2.

ACADEMIC FAIRS

Students compete in science and history fairs for local, regional and state honors. Our students also participate in Saints fairs, geography bees and spelling bees at all levels of competition, as well as "Patriot's Pen" essay contests and art contests.
